RESIDENCE PHOTOGRAPHER

Summary Statement

The Residence Photographer is a part-time position responsible for providing marketing and event photography of residence activities. A schedule of monthly events will be provided in advance; the applicant must have flexible evening hours as well as some weekends to accommodate the schedule of events.



Major Responsibilities

- Practice punctual attendance to assigned events.
- Provide color corrected digital files within 3 working days of event. Photos must be sharp, not too underexposed or overexposed, so that they may be utilized for print and web promotional materials.
- Possess an attentiveness to email/text as this is the primary form of communication prior to the event. Respond in a timely manner to supervisor requests/questions.
- Have a cooperative attitude and willingness to take direction and feedback.
- Represent CHOC and OC with a pleasant, respectful and professional demeanor through all interactions.
- Able to work independently as well as part of the Residence Life team.

Required Qualifications

- Must be an Olds College student and live in Residence
- Must have experience with digital photography
- Use of personal equipment to be used to shoot events
- Possess intermediate to advanced knowledge of photo editing software
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Regular availability on nights and weekends
- Work creatively within deadlines

Hours per Week: Work is event-specific, approximately 5 hours per week.

Wage: Monthly stipend of \$300/month
